Behavioral Health Community Services Awareness Initiative:

Informational Session for Region 5 Law Enforcement, Courts and Emergency Personnel

This initiative has been developed by the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities (DBHDD) at the request of the Georgia Sheriffs Association and the Georgia Association of County Commissioners. The goal of these sessions is to provide communities with information on community behavioral health programs and resources provided by the State through local and regional community based services.
