### SERVICE: Community Living Support (CLS)

<b>CHECK ALL THAT APPLY:</b>	X	<b>SERVICE DESCRIPTION:</b> Community Living Support (CLS) Services are individualized supports intended to assist the person with the achievement, preservation, or improvement in skills. The services are offered to individuals who live in their own or family home. Personal care/assistance may be a component part of CLS services but may not comprise the entirety of the services. The amount of personal care/assistance is specific to the needs of the Individual, as determined by the Supports Intensity Scale, the Health Risk Screening Tool, and other person-centered assessments. The service needs may be addressed in one or more of the following areas: Activities of daily living, personal grooming and health care, interpersonal relationships, mobility, home management, and use of leisure time.

### SPECIAL ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

A. Services are provided only to Individuals who require in-home supports.

B. The need for CLS services must be reflected in the Individual Service Plan (ISP) that is approved by the Regional Office before services can be provided.

### ITEMS COVERED:

1. Social, leisure, and adaptive skill development that assists the individual in continuing home living.
2. Personal care, protective oversight and supervision as a component part but not as the entirety of the services.
3. Training in activities of daily living, such as bathing, dressing, toileting, transfers, hygiene, light housework, laundry, meal preparation, grocery shopping, using telephone, medication and money management
4. Medically related services, such as basic first aid, arranging, accompanying, providing individual transportation to medical appointments, and reminders and/or assistance self-administration of medication.
5. Implementation of a behavioral support plan to reduce inappropriate behaviors and to acquire new skills and behaviors.
6. Transportation to grocery or personal shopping, banking, and other community activities supporting continued home living.
7. CLS RN and LPN services which are defined as only routine nursing services that are integral to meeting the daily needs of the person in his/her own or family home.

### ITEMS NOT COVERED:

1. Services may not be delivered to a person living in a home leased or owned by the service delivery agency, foster care homes, host homes, personal care homes.
2. Educational and related services needed by children for whom the Department of Education is responsible.
3. CLS services that duplicate or are provided at the same time of the same day as Community Access or Supported Employment services.
4. Payment is not made for the cost of room and board, including the cost of building maintenance, upkeep and improvements.
5. Payment is not made to members of the individual's immediate family, except as approved as indicated in Part II Policies and Procedures for NOW, Chapter 1200, Section 1214.
