The service is not intended to replace any formal or informal transportation options; whenever possible family members, friends, neighbors or community based organizations that are able to provide this service at no charge should be utilized. Transportation services that are provided as a stand alone service and not available for use when transportation is an included element of another waiver service.

SPECIAL ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

- A. The need for Transportation services must be reflected in the Individual Service Plan (ISP) that is approved by the Regional Office.
- B. The unavailability of other resources for transportation must be documented in the ISP.
- C. Transportation Services must be approved prior being used.

ITEMS COVERED:

- 1. Transportation for the person to waiver services and other community, non-medical services, activities, resources, and organizations typically utilized by the general population.
- 2. Transportation of one participant to Supported Employment Services community work sites.
- 3. Negotiating or the arrangement of commercial transportation services available to the community at-large such as Marta, buses or other public transportation options.

ITEMS NOT COVERED:

- 1. Transportation to school (through 12th grade).
- 2. Transportation that is included as an element of another waiver service i.e. Community Residential Alternative Services, Community Living Supports, Prevocational services, Supportive Employment Group and Community Access Services.
- 3. Transportation provided through non emergency Medicaid transportation services.
- 4. Transportation services available under the Medicaid State Plan.
