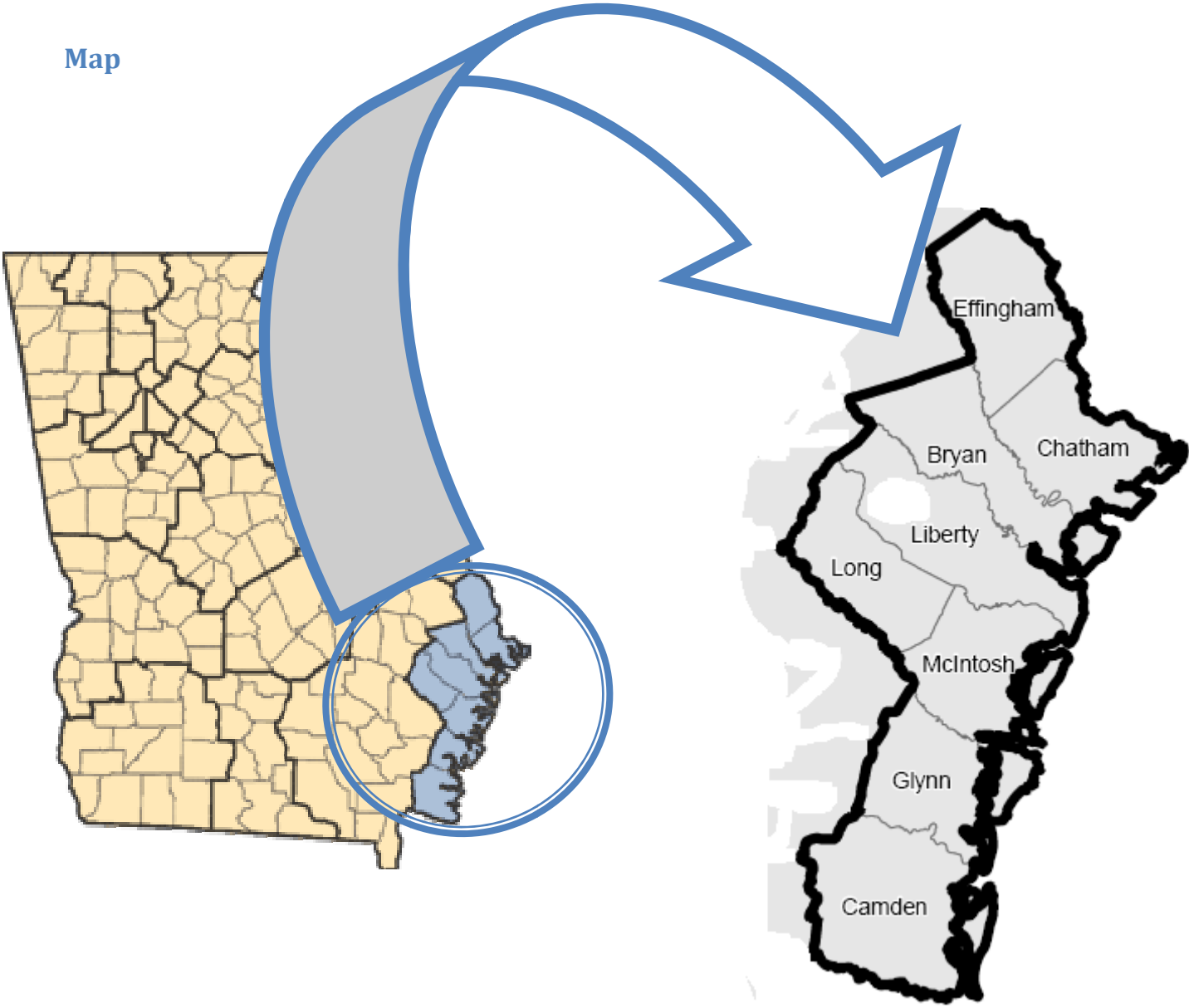

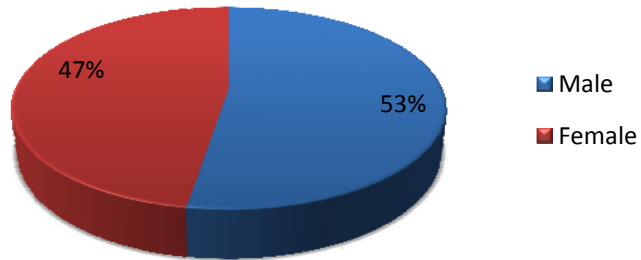

Map



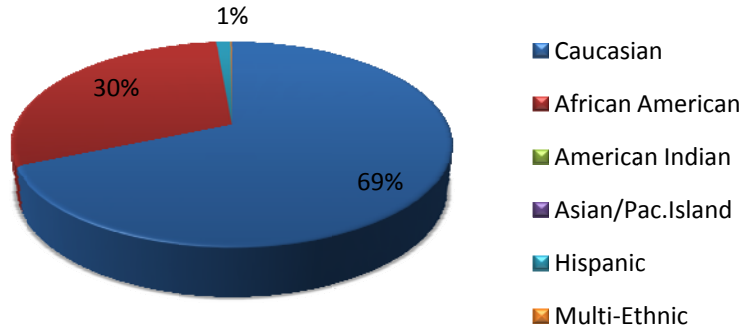

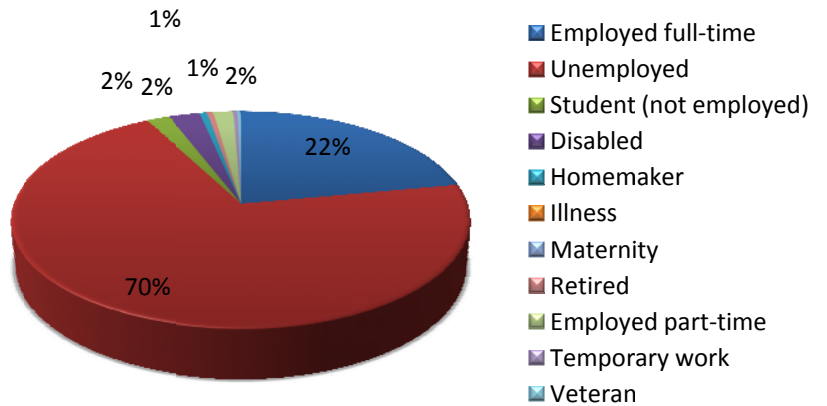

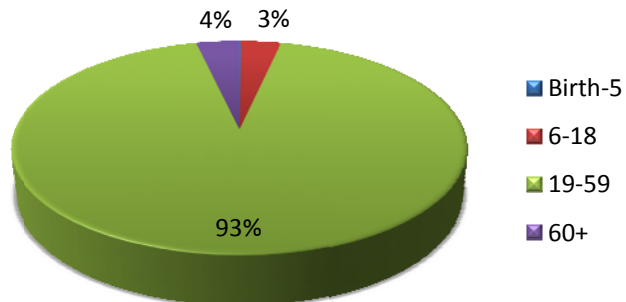

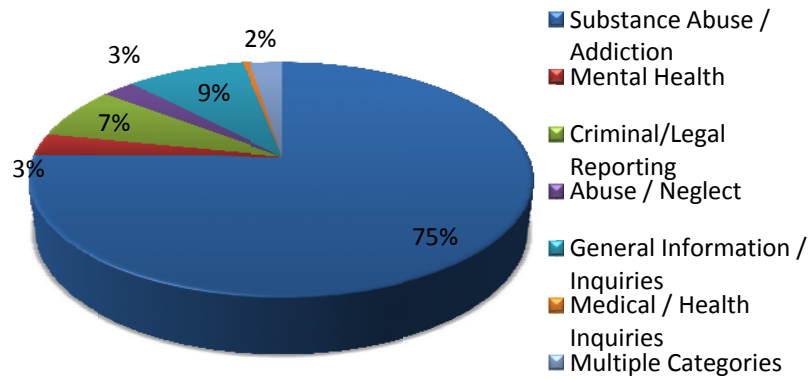

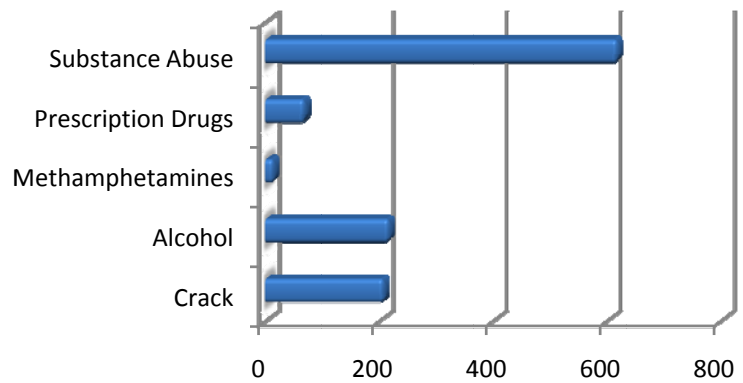
