HB 911 [Appropriations Bill FY23]:

DBHDD given funds to complete a study of the Medicaid Rehabilitation Option which it manages with the DCH

Context and Process:

ARPA HCBS

- DCH/DBHDD Plan to implement rate increases with relief funds provided to state;
- Desire to implement by FY2024
- Funds must be used before March 31, 2025

Session I: Rate Study Stakeholder Engagement

Speed/Commitment/Timeline:

- Requires completed study;
- Requires Departmental validation;
- Requires DCH Board Notice;
- Requires DCH Board Hearing;
- Requires DCH Board Approval;
- Requires submission to and approval by CMS;
- Requires IT modifications;
- ENDS MARCH 31, 2025

Rate Setting Project - Structure

DCH and DBHDD – Governance with Deloitte

Provides Executive Steering to the Overarching Contract Project

Consists of DBHDD Leadership and Deloitte (DCH ad hoc)

DBHDD Leadership Group

Provider-populated Steering Workgroup (marketplace representation)

Will shape and inform standard rate setting processes and procedures

Provider perspectives regarding rate, rate structure, and leading drivers of costs

Will provide feedback on methodologies and approaches to the survey to assure relevance and efficiency for collecting necessary data

Core Rate Workgroup

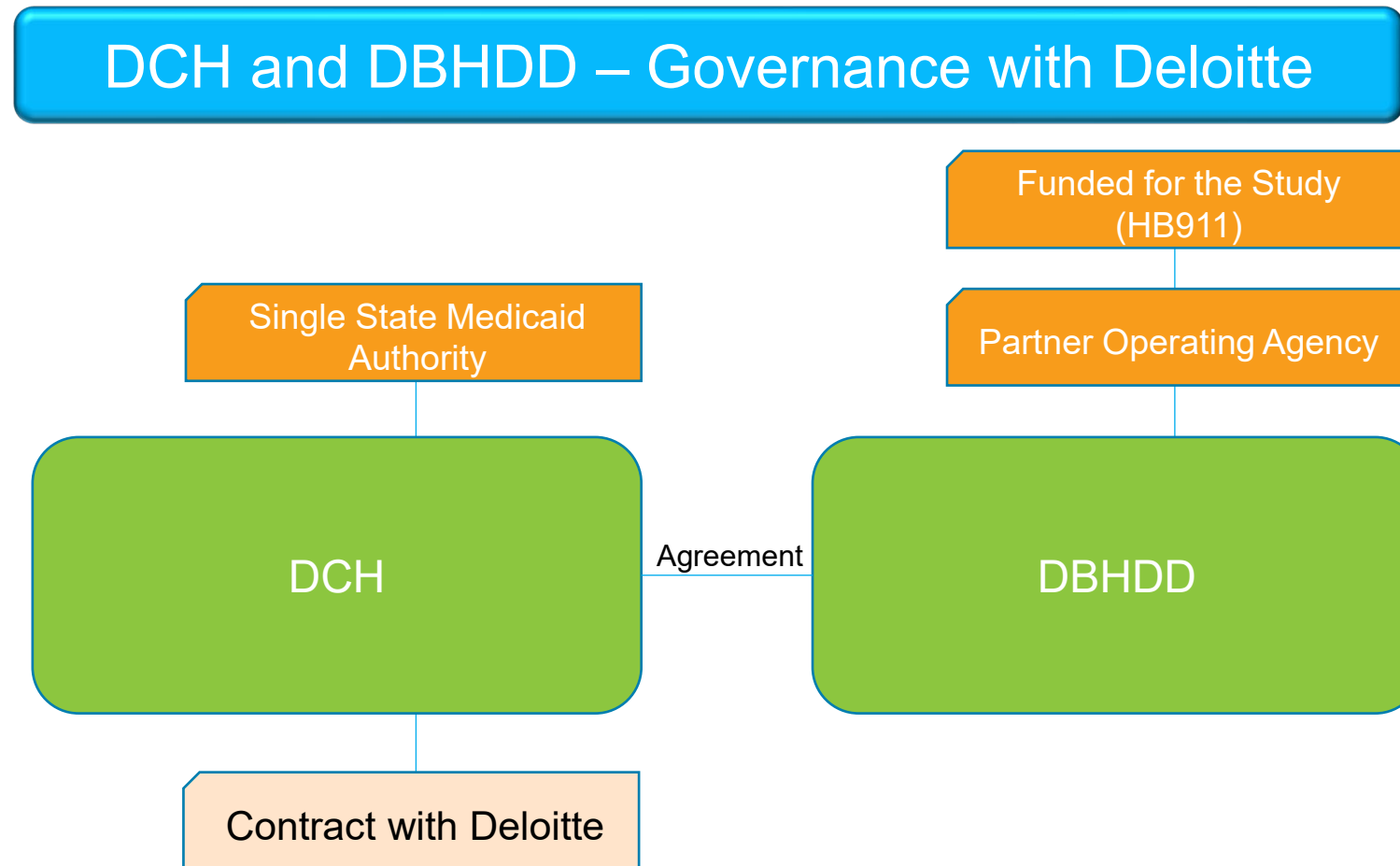
Broader group which will be the surveyed body of provider agencies

Will convene at key points in the project

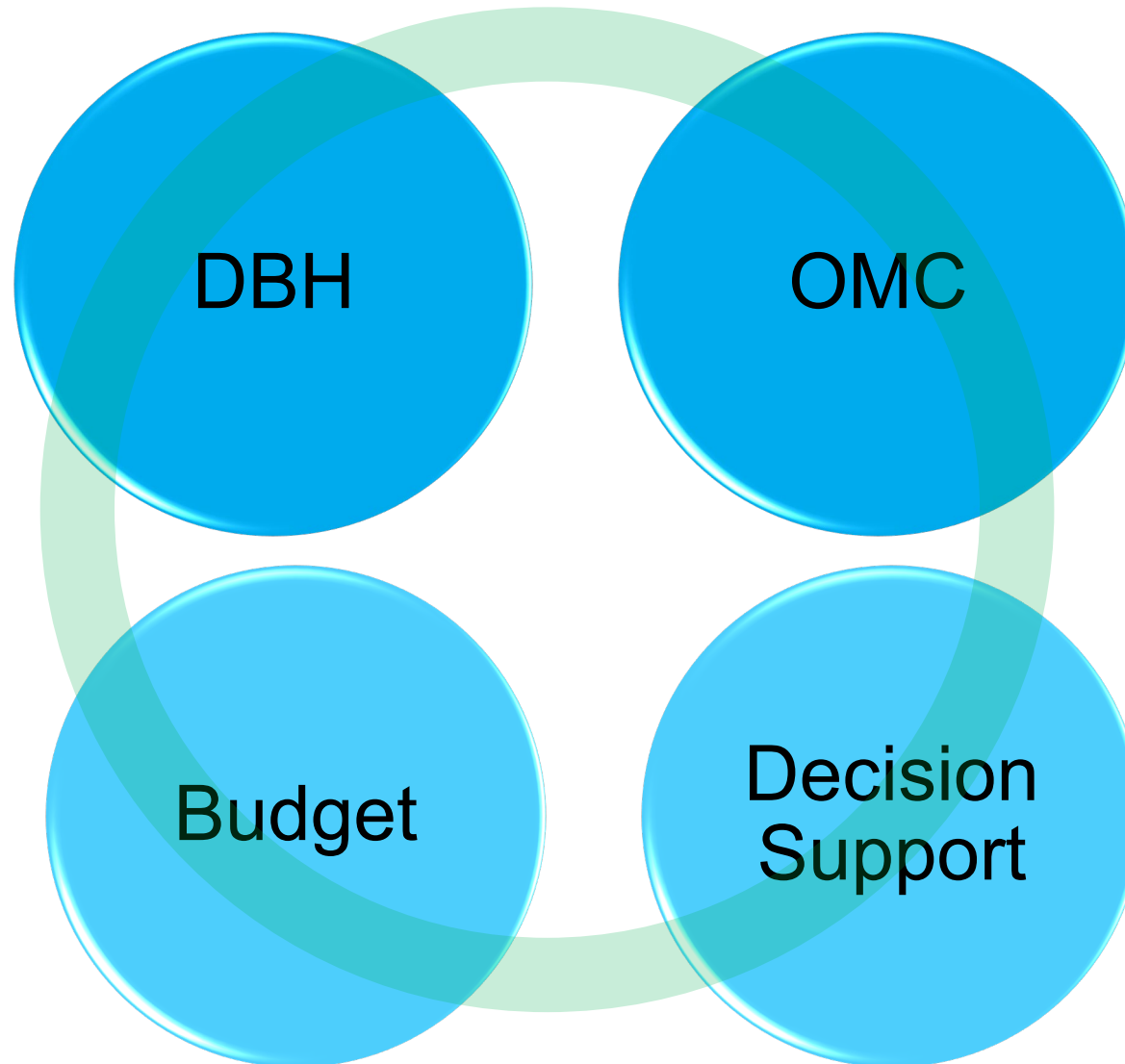
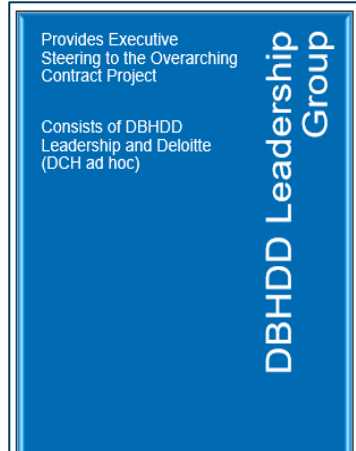
