Enhancing Mental Health Treatment in Georgia Act – Senate Bill 4

- Examining the current mental health landscape.
- Assessing whether current the Medicaid program provides effective care for the portion of Georgia's population suffering from mental illness/substance use disorders.
- Assessing how non-Medicaid programs work to provide effective health care for the portion of Georgia's population suffering from mental illness/substance use disorders.
- Determining the effect of lack of treatment for mental illness on Georgia's hospitals, emergency rooms, law enforcement, prisons, and jails.
- Understanding the link between substance use disorders and serious mental illness to provide comprehensive and effective treatment.
- Determining what changes could be made to Georgia's Medicaid program to increase access to care for those suffering from mental illness/substance use disorders.
- Developing complete application for Medicaid block grant funding for mental health services and substance use disorder prevention and treatment.
