What's Next?

• COMP waiver to be renewed in 2015

Public forums January–March to solicit stakeholder comment

• DBHDD will:

- Consider service edits, additions, or other changes
- Collaborate with the Georgia Department of Community Health in rate analysis and all aspects of the renewal
- Submit a NOW waiver amendment application to align the two waiver programs

Timeline

- COMP waiver program expires Dec. 31, 2015 unless renewed
- Department of Community Health must submit renewal application by Sept. 30, 2015
- Stakeholders may continue to submit comment throughout the renewal process by:
 - Offering comment in public forums
 - Attending other events and networking with fellow stakeholders
 - Submitting comment through the "feedback form" on the DBHDD website at www.dbhdd.georgia.gov/nowcompcommunity-forums
