

PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULES

Pursuant to the Georgia Administrative Procedures Act, Official Code of Georgia Annotated (O.C.G.A.) § 50-13-1, et seq., the Georgia Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities (DBHDD) is required to provide public notice of its intent to adopt, amend, or repeal certain rules other than interpretative rules or general statements of policy. Accordingly, DBHDD hereby provides notice of its intent to adopt **Rules and Regulations for Emergency Receiving, Evaluating, and Treatment Facilities, GA COMP. R. & REGS. 82-8-1.**

These rules are being proposed pursuant to the authority granted to DBHDD in Chapters 3 and 7 of Title 37 of the Official Code of Georgia. An exact copy of the proposed rules and regulations and a synopsis are attached to this public notice.
