Region 4: Community Building and Closure of SWSH

Rationale:

- 1. Serving people closer to home in community settings
- 2. Cannot simultaneously build institutions and communities
- 3. Once individuals with DD move to the community, cannot maintain the facility to support the reduced census
- Pathways for 4 populations served at hospital
- Community investment: \$17.5 million Settlement dollars
 - Three Behavioral Health Crisis Centers open before closure (Valdosta, Thomasville, Albany).
 - Intensive Case Mgt Teams, ACT teams, mobile crisis, CST
 - 78 Crisis Beds, 18 Temporary Observation beds
- Multiple approaches for hospital employees

Update on Department of Justice

Visit 5/23/13 from DOJ

- Very positive reports regarding BH Settlement services:
 ACT, Supported Employment and Housing
- Concerns about the quality of placements in community

Implementation of 45 Day Suspension of Transitions

- Develop Special Quality review teams in each region
- Training and technical assistance from Elizabeth Jones, Independent reviewer
- Review of 79 individuals plus 40 with Transition plans, as well as at-risk population
- Can we plan, monitor, correct and assure quality

 - BH (61)
