BEHAVIORAL HEALTH COORDINATING COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY

September 26, 2012

Chairman Frank Berry, Commissioner of the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities (DBHDD) called the September 26, 2012 meeting of the Behavioral Health Coordinating Council (BHCC) to order at 10:05 a.m.

Council members attending were: Commissioners Frank Berry, Brenda Fitzgerald, M.D., Clyde Reese, Esq., and David Cook; Disabilities Services Ombudsman Corinna Magelund; Parent Representative Diane Reeder; Adult Consumer Representative Julie Spores; State Representative Katie Dempsey; State Senator Renee Unterman; and Family Representative Stanley Jones, Esq. Commissioner Gale Buckner was represented by Miguel Fernandez.

The Council took the following actions:

- Unanimously approved and adopted the June 21, 2012 meeting minutes with additions; and
- Reviewed BHCC functions and requirements;
- Appointed Senator Renee Unterman chair of the Nominating Committee (the appointment was made by BHCC Chair, Commissioner Frank Berry in accordance with the by-laws). Commissioner Clyde Reese and Family Representative Stanley Jones agreed to serve on the committee. No formal vote was taken; and
- Decided on three main focal areas: partnerships (to include housing, children and adolescents, behavioral health services, etc.); workforce development; and the sharing of health information. No formal vote was taken.
