2021 DFCS Family First Provider Readiness Assessment

DEADLINE EXTENSION March 10, 2021

Our partners at the Division of Family and Children's Services (DFCS) are asking for your participation in a survey to support them in preparing for changes under the **Blueprint for Families First**.

The Family First Prevention Service Act (Family First) is a federal initiative to develop evidence-based mental health, substance abuse, and parenting services delivered to children at risk of foster care entry and their families as well as pregnant and parenting youth in foster care.

The purpose of the Family First Provider Readiness Assessment Survey is to help our partners at the DFCS understand the array of prevention services statewide. This will also help identify gaps in services and inform the selection of services to be funded through the Family First Act.

The survey should be completed by the clinical director or someone familiar with number of clients served, program specific information, and staff training practices. It should take between 15-30 minutes to complete.
