Due to the impact of Hurricane Helene, Governor Kemp and the Georgia Emergency Management and Homeland Security Agency (GEMA) have declared a State of Emergency for all 159 counties throughout the State. Additionally, the Department of Health and Human Services has declared a Public Health Emergency, as authorized under section 319 of the public Health Service Act, for the State of Florida, Georgia, and South Carolina.
