IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT DBDHD's New Background Check System

Introducing CheckPT

DBHDD is in the process of developing a new application, CheckPT, to reduce challenges in the background check process. CheckPT is being developed by the same vendor who developed GCHEXS for the Department of Community Health (DCH) and it will integrate with the GBI's vendor Idemia.



CheckPT will:

- Give providers the ability to approve registrations, leading to faster hiring. This will eliminate the need to email registration forms to DBHDD and wait for registration approval.
- Automate checks and record results of web sites which providers currently check (registries, exclusion lists, etc.), where possible.
- Give providers the ability to review and record findings of professional licensure checks when applicable.
- Automate notifications to applicants and providers.
- Store determination letters, thereby replacing CHRIS.

CheckPT is anticipated to go-live in early June. However, this is entirely dependent upon the work being done by GBI and Idemia.

DBHDD will provide training both in-person and virtually prior to the launch and will communicate additional information as it becomes available.

We will also be offering "office hours" after the go-live where providers can join a meeting to get help with any issues or questions you may have.
