The Georgia Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities, Division of Developmental Disabilities, in collaboration with IntellectAbility, continues to offer Person-Centered Thinking (PCT) Training to Support Coordinators, Planning List Administrators, State Service Coordinators, and DBHDD Provider. This foundational PCT training is key to applying basic person-centered approaches to those receiving supports and services.

PCT training also helps promote compliance with the Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) Settings Rule.

Person-Centered Training equips supporters to work with both the electronic person-centered description (ePCD) and the one-page description (1PD). These online documents allow for the collection of vital person-centered information.
