### SPECIAL ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

- A. The need for vehicle adaptation services must be relative to the Individual's disability.
- Individuals receiving only vehicle adaptation services must have a specific goal relative to the service in the Individual Service Plan that is approved by the Regional Office.
- C. Medical necessity for vehicle adaptation services must be documented through an order by a Georgia Licensed Professional within the scope of his or her practice.

### ITEMS COVERED:

1. Hydraulic Lifts.
2. Ramps.
3. Special Seats or interior modifications that allow ease of access into and out of vehicle.
4. Repair of a prior vehicle adaptation provided the repair is less than replacement; Replacement of a prior existing vehicle adaptation if replacement is less than a repair.
5. Vehicle Adaptations are limited to a Person's or his/her family's privately owned vehicle.

### ITEMS NOT COVERED:

1. Adaptation, repair or replacement costs for adaptations to provider-owned vehicles; Adaptation, repair or replacement costs for adaptations to leased vehicles.
2. Adaptations less than three (3) years old.
3. Vehicle back up sensors or alarm systems.
4. Adaptations necessary due to individual's neglect or abuse; regularly scheduled maintenance of the vehicle or the vehicle adaptation.
5. Adaptations for the purchase or lease of a vehicle; extended warranties or scheduled maintenance programs.
6. Adaptations of general utility that are not of direct medical or remedial benefit to the individual.
