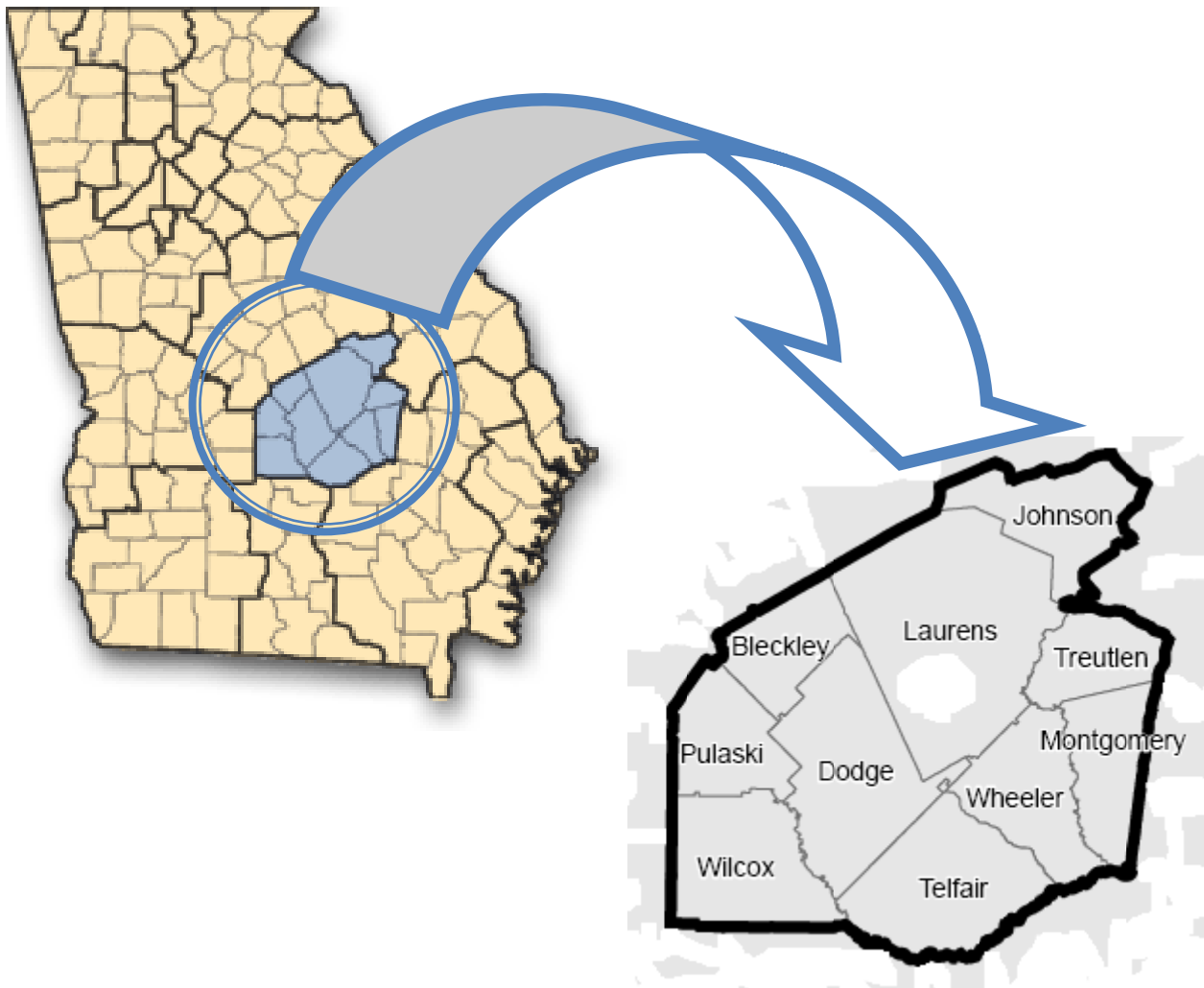

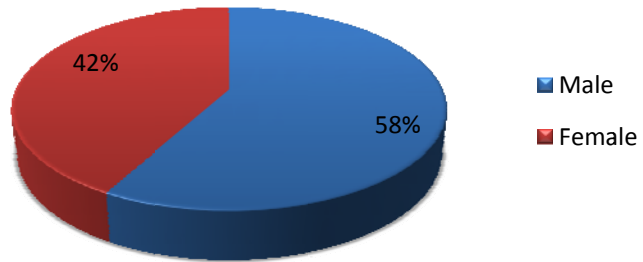

Map



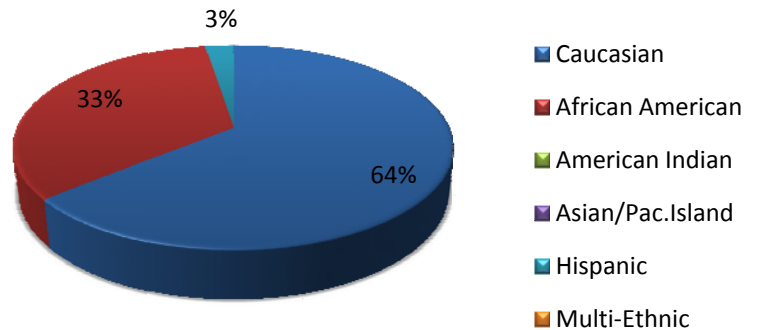
