TRAINING ANNOUNCEMENT

Assessing and Managing Suicide Risk: Core Competencies for Providers of Mental Health Services

The Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities, Suicide Prevention is offering this training program to acquaint public, private, and community mental health providers with the competencies needed to assess and manage individuals who are at heightened suicide risk. It provides an overview of what is needed to provide competent assessment and management in provider settings. **This training will focus on work with adults**.

Intended Audience: This training is intended for DBHDD provider clinical leadership (e.g. Medical Directors, Clinical Directors, and/or Quality Assurance Managers) and other licensed providers of private mental health services. A 2.5 day Instructor Training for this course is being planned for late spring/early summer. People who have attended this course will be eligible to apply for the Instructor Training course so they can train within their own agencies and settings.

This training is facilitated by **Dr. Doreen Marshall.** Dr. Doreen Marshall is Senior Director of Education and Prevention at the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention and adjunct professor, Argosy University. She is a licensed professional counselor and a licensed psychologist in the state of Georgia.
