PROVIDER RECRUITMENT AND APPLICATION TO BECOME A PROVIDER OF DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES SERVICES

The Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities announces the upcoming Open Enrollment period for Developmental Disabilities Services, January 1-31, 2015.

The Enrollment period for potential providers occurs two times per year January 1-31 and July 1-31. The Department is currently seeking providers who will provide services for persons with Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities. It is preferable that these providers have the capacity to deliver services to persons who require significant medical supports, support with behavioral challenges or who may be dually diagnosed with a mental illness.

NOTE: The Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities/Division of Developmental Disabilities **does not guarantee referrals of individuals with Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities to any provider.** Individuals with Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities and their families always have choice in the selection of providers.
