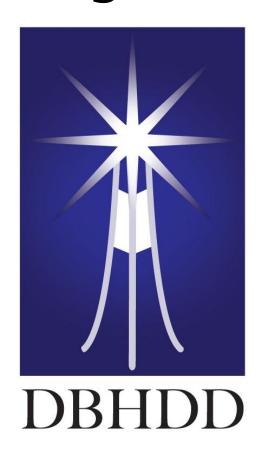

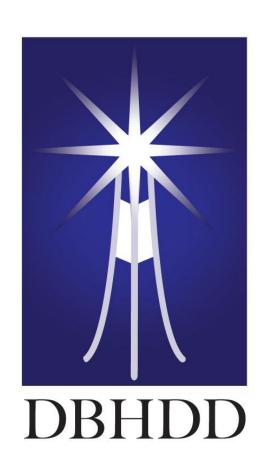
- DOJ ADA Compliance Success in Behavioral Health

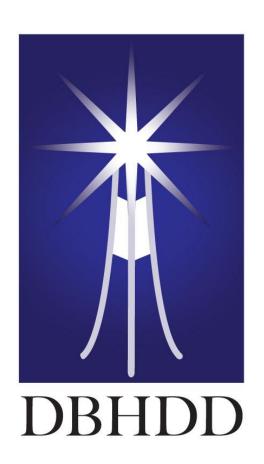
