NOW & COMP Waiver Policy Changes: Level of Care Re-Evaluation

Informational session provided via Conference Call & Internet

The Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities Division of Developmental Disabilities will host an informational session to discuss the Level of Care Re-Evaluation section that is covered under the new NOW & COMP Waiver Program Policies and Procedures which became effective January 2013.

These sessions will be mandatory for Support Coordinators, Regional LOC Nurses, and Facility Registered Nurses who are responsible for level of care re-evaluations at ICF-IDs within the DD Units. Regional and State Office staff are welcome to attend; however, they must register.

The learning objectives for this hour and a half informational session are for participants to:

- Know how to complete each component of the Level of Care (LOC) Re-Evaluation Form
- Understand protocol timelines for LOC Re-Evaluation Form submission, review, and approval
- Be familiar with NOW and COMP waiver policies on level of care re-evaluation

The presenter for this training will be Dr. Darlene Meador, Director of Strategy and Special Projects with the DBHDD Division of Developmental Disabilities.
