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DBHDD Vision & Goal

Vision - Every person who participates in our services leads a satisfying, independent life with dignity and respect.

Goal - The goal is for all transitioned individuals to receive adequate services and supports in the community and to achieve independence, integration, and a meaningful life.



Establishes New Rates

- Service rates and rate changes must be approved by CMS
- 2014 General Assembly approved rate increases for:
 - Community Access Services
 - Prevocational Services
 - Supported Employment Services
 - Community Residential Services
 - Community Living Support Services
 - Support Coordination



Significant Features of the Waiver Amendment

- *Proposes new rates established through 2014 General Assembly rate increases*
- *Submits two new services for CMS consideration*
- *Separates skilled nursing services from the context of community residential and community living services*



Services to be Submitted for Approval

- **Intensive Support Coordination**
 - In response to the needs of the ADA population
- **Behavioral Support Services**
 - Identified as a need in bridging behavior support plan development, training and implementation strategies



Separates skilled nursing services

- Nursing services currently available only within the context of residential and in-home (CLS) services
- Amendment extracts nursing services and allows stand-alone service planning and delivery regardless of setting
