- You may choose to participate in the poster contest, the art walk or both. If you opt only to display at the art walk, simply bring your poster to the Amphitheater at or before 9:30 am on the day of the Red Ribbon Campaign kickoff.

**NOTE:** We sincerely hope your school or organization will attend the 2014 Governors Red Ribbon Campaign kickoff. However, due to the anticipated number of schools wanting to participate in the celebration of talents, including singing, dancing, poetry reading, or stepping, and due to the limited time frame:

- We must limit the number of acts and the length of performance onstage (<u>no</u> <u>more than five minutes</u>);
- Your application to participate in the celebration of talents must be received on or before Friday, September 26;

- Those schools wishing to participate in the talent showcase please indicate that on the reservation form, and complete a short application form;
- To increase the chance of selection, you may wish to send in a short (no more than five minutes) video with your application or perhaps a paragraph or two about the proposed act.
- If you wish to attend the Red Ribbon kickoff celebration, and not participate in the celebration of talents, you must complete the attached reservation form and return it to us no later than Tuesday, September 30!
